**Main Idea:** While there are many voices competing for our attention, there is one voice of hope that we should fix our ears upon.

- II. The Voice Of Truth (13:1-5, 15b-41; 14:1, 3, 14-17, 21)
- III. Let Us Be The People Who Speak Hope (13:9-12, 42-44, 46-52; 14:1, 4-6, 18-20)

### Discussion Questions:

- 1.) What 'voices' do you find yourself listening to the most? What message do you find yourself relying on?
- 2.) Are the 'voices' you are most listening to in alignment with man's ideas or God's Word? What changes do you need to make to ensure God's Word is the loudest in your life?
- 3.) Consider this past week. What message are you spreading? A message of hope or fear? Are your words proclaiming the gospel of Christ, or are your words putting your hope in man?
