



Drive-In Easter Service – April 12th, 2020 at 10:00am

This Easter we will be celebrating the resurrection of Christ with a drive-in service! We believe that this is a responsible way to gather as the church, while protecting those who are vulnerable. If you were unable to attend our service last Sunday, please see the guidelines below. If you are unable to attend, please follow us on Facebook where we will be livestreaming the service. It will also be available on our YouTube channel (surfsidebaptist) the following day.

The leadership of the church is evaluating best practices for our church in light of all government mandates and recommendations. Therefore, we will be having **no on-campus activities through April 30th**. The office will be closed except for essential business and will be closed on Monday, April 13th for Easter. Continue reading for more information about the drive-in service and the church during this time.

Drive-in Guidelines:

- 1) **Only fully enclosed vehicles will be allowed on our campus.**
 - NO golf-carts, bikes, convertibles, or walking onto the campus.
- 2) **We would ask that you do not get out of your vehicle for ANY REASON.**
 - Bathrooms will not be opened.
 - The playground will be closed.
 - Standing, sitting in lawn chairs, etc., will not be allowed.
- 3) **Please park 6 feet from other cars, and only roll down your windows half-way.**

When you arrive:

- At each entrance a parking attendant will direct you where to park. If you need to park near an exit, please let them know.
- We will have speakers outside for everyone to hear from the cars.
- We will also be broadcasting to FM radio frequency 89.1 for you to listen on your car radio.

At the end:

- Parking attendants will help you pull out in an orderly manner.
- At each exit, there will be a basket available to drop off your offerings.

We look forward to seeing you for this special time of worship!
