As a church we are continuing to make steps to "reopen" slowly but surely. We are continuing with the format of a 9:00am drive-in service and 10:30am sanctuary service. We have also begun mid-week Bible study and prayer meeting on Wednesdays at 10:00am in the Sanctuary. All of these have gone extremely well and are great ways to worship together as a church.

On June 14th, we will take another big step in "reopening" our church. That is the Sunday when our Sunday School Classes will resume. Classes will meet on campus; however, classes will meet during two different hours and may meet in different rooms to ensure classes can practice social distancing. Different adult classes will meet during both the 9:00am and 10:30am services.
