- Overflow for 10:30 service One great problem we are encountering is the need for overflow in our inside service. We are almost hitting capacity each Sunday! We are asking for our members to volunteer to be on a rotation to once a month attend service in the Fellowship Hall and watch via TV. This will help ensure our guests have an opportunity to come inside safely. If you are willing to volunteer, please let the church office know.
- Stage for drive-in service As we continue to see the need for a drive-in service, we are considering building a semi-permanent stage area outside near the pond. This would increase visibility for the service and provide some protection from the weather. More details will be provided once they are determined.
