Last night we had our business meeting to prepare for the church year that will begin in September. I am thankful to be a part of a church that conducts business in a God-honoring manner. - Overflow for 10:30 service – One great problem we are encountering is the need for overflow in our inside service. We are almost hitting capacity each Sunday! We are asking for our members to volunteer to be on a rotation to once a month attend service in the Fellowship Hall and watch via TV. This will help ensure our guests have an opportunity to come inside safely. If you are willing to volunteer, please let the church office know.
- Stage for drive-in service – As we continue to see the need for a drive-in service, we are considering building a semi-permanent stage area outside near the pond. This would increase visibility for the service and provide some protection from the weather. More details will be provided once they are determined.
