Our aim is to use Trunk or Treat to share Christ with entire families and not just children. Therefore, because it is an all family outreach, it is an all church event! We need all hands on deck – that means you!

Now before I tell you where we need help, I want you to know that our Children's Committee is taking this event and COVID-19 seriously. They have talked at length about how to continue with this night in a responsible manner. At the same time, we know that some in our church will be unable to serve this year in person, and that's ok! Below you will find something that everyone can help with:
