Church Family,

An uncertain year has become even more uncertain. Today, two days after the election, we are still waiting anxiously to hear who our president will be. To make matters worse, it appears we may not have an answer for some time now. Our world is fearful, tired, and for many, hopeless. As Christians we claim to have peace, hope, and joy, but the question is, are we practicing that this week? Certainly, we as Christ-followers are not immune to current events. We are not outsiders looking in; we live in the midst of the chaos. However, as we navigate these waters our perspective and response should be fundamentally different than the world's. As we watch the events in our nation unfold, here are a few things that come to my mind:

- 1. **This week, idols are crashing** For believers, we are thankful to live in a free country, with the right to vote yet Christ alone is worthy of worship. We are reminded, this week that we live in a world that is broken and that the systems of this world are broken. Our level of anguish when we are reminded they are broken may reveal to what level we idolize them.
- 2. This week, false hope is disappointing Prior to the election many expressed they desired a clear result, regardless of the outcome, so that there would be peace. However, this week Russell Moore aptly noted, "The divisions in the country are real, and aren't going away, regardless of who is ultimately certified as the electoral winner this year." Many people had a false hope that this election would bring peace and stability to our country. However, regardless of how the election unfolds, true peace will never be achieved by an election but only through the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- 3. This week, the true king is uncontested I hope you will join us Sunday morning as we look at Revelation 19. Such an appropriate passage for our time. Although the office of president is uncertain, the King is coming! What is most apparent in the passage is that when He comes, there will be no contest! His reign will be clear, certain, and unshakeable.

Church family, the sovereignty of God is not a cliché – it is a foundational truth to our faith. Stop and examine yourself today – is the sovereignty of God something you just talk about, or is it something you truly believe? If we truly believe that God reigns still today, it will dramatically impact how we walk through the coming days. As the world is searching for hope, will they find it in us?
