What does a pastor do? That's a question I get from time to time, especially from children. It certainly is a fair question; besides preaching and teaching a few hours a week, what is a pastor called to do? With all questions about the life and practice of the church, it is imperative that we go to scripture to find answers. Thankfully, Paul in Ephesians gives clear guidance on what a pastor should do. Specifically, in Ephesians 4:12 he says that pastors are, "to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ."

Did you read the verse? Notice that a pastor is called to equip the church to effectively do ministry. Yes, a pastor is called to do ministry himself, but in the Bible every member of the church is called to do ministry. The pastor is called to help equip and empower the members of the church so that they can go and do ministry. Instead of just one man doing ministry, a church that truly impacts its community is one in which every member is on mission.

One way we are seeking to be faithful to the call to "equip the saints" is by offering our adult Equip Classes on Sunday nights, starting February 21st. We will be offering three different classes that you can choose from. Each class has the goal of equipping our church to be more like Christ and to fulfill the work of the ministry.
