Church family,

D. L. Moody once wrote “If I could relive my life, I would devote my entire ministry to reaching children for God!” As a pastor, I am constantly reminded of how important a healthy and vibrant children’s ministry is to the life of the church. In many cases, families will make their decision on whether to come to a church based on how their child will be ministered to. Even more important is that most people who give their life to Christ do so as a child. Children’s ministry impacts a person’s entire life as well as their eternity! Through children’s ministry, entire families are touched by the gospel, and we are training up the next generation of Christ-followers!

It is my prayer that as a church we will see the need to minister to children, and rally around our children’s ministries when there are needs. I say this because currently we have significant needs for our children’s ministry. There are several needs for workers on Sunday morning. As a result, our children’s ministry is hindered and our volunteers are being stretched thin. Unfortunately, we have several workers who rarely even come to worship because they are weekly involved with children’s ministry. We need to come together and help them shoulder this very important load.

There are two areas of specific needs on Sunday mornings for children. The good news is that regardless of your comfort level with working with children, we have a spot for you! Also, most of the needs are only a once-a-month commitment. That means you would only have miss Sunday School or Worship one time a month.

So with that said the two main areas of help are:

1. **5 people** who will help with our children’s sign in desk. This person is the primary greeter for children and their families, helps kids sign in, and stays at the desk during the hour for safety purposes.
2. **9 people** who will help with our children’s church during the 10:30am hour. Currently, our children’s ministry is growing and we are seeing 15-20 children during that time. Unfortunately, I was just informed that currently we have two Sundays out of the month with not one person signed up to teach our children.

I write this in love, but to gently encourage you to help in our children’s ministry. With the size of our church, we should be able to fill each of these slots in order so that we may carry out our children’s ministry with excellence. 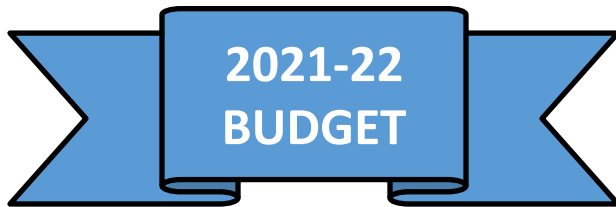

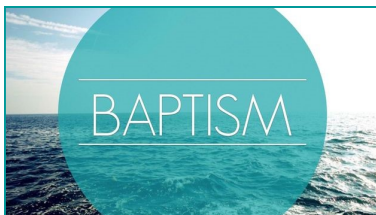

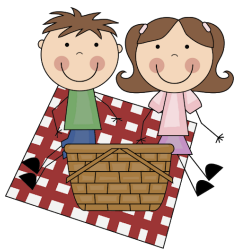
