I want to thank you for praying for us while we took the students to summer camp last week. It was a very impactful week for everyone in attendance.

The theme of camp this year was Dwell. We studied Psalm 46 and learned that God is our Helper who can always be found in times of trouble. We talked about 4 aspects of God being our Helper: (1) He is our Refuge in times of trouble, (2) He is with us in the good and bad, (3) He is faithful to provide exactly what we need, and (4) He invites us to rest in Him - rest from our chronic busyness and rest from our worksrighteousness.

As many of you know, events like camp typically give students a unique opportunity to open up and have conversations that they wouldn't normally be willing to have. That is exactly what happened for us at summer camp. I'm thankful to God for the work He did in our student's lives at camp, and I ask that you would join me in praying that God continues that work, leading to the salvation and sanctification of our students.

At the same time, would you join me in praying for Centrikid? This weekend (July 9-11), we will send 4 adults and 14 children to Gardner-Webb University in Boiling Springs, NC to have tons of fun, hear Biblical teaching, engage in Christ-centered worship, and learn more about what it means to be a follower of Jesus. Pray that God moves in the lives of our children, as they are not the future of the church, but the church of today.

Camp is a wonderful opportunity, and I'm thankful for all of you who have committed to praying for the children, youth, and adults involved!
