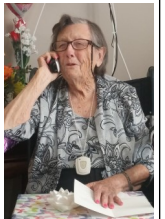


New Church Members

Second Semester starts Sunday night, October 17th and will run for 7 weeks, ending on December 12

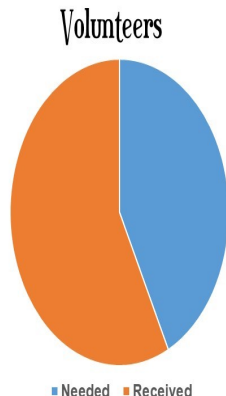
