God tells us in every situation to give thanks, because this if what He wants from us--it is the will of God that we do this. So this Thanksgiving season let us all remember to be more thankful—thankful for His grace, His mercy, His provision, and His strength. By doing so we may find that the things of this world will grow strangely dim as we become more grateful for all God has given us. November is the time to traditionally count our blessings and name them one by one, but the season of thanksgiving should be year-round! How different our own lives and the life of churches would be if we were grateful for our blessings, while realizing that some things we don't consider blessings turn out to be such.
