Mission Of First Baptist Surfside

Exalt Jesus in worship

We are a multi-generational, multi-ethnic family of Christ followers.

We personally know the one true and living God through the person and work of Jesus Christ and the indwelling Holy Spirit.

We worship God in our daily lives by obeying His Word, praying continually, and enjoying His presence. We gather weekly to worship by passionately singing together, engaging in expository preaching, giving joyfully, and reverently seeking God through prayer.

Equip Christ followers

We are disciples of Jesus Christ who make disciples.

We know that a disciple of Christ is one who seeks to obey, trust, and imitate Jesus daily.
