- Families Each child that comes represents a family. Therefore, VBS is not just a children's ministry it is a whole family ministry.
  - Pray for parents to have a peace about dropping their child off and that they will feel the love of Christ even as they drop off and pick up.
  - Pray for children to go home each night excited for the gospel and that this will be contagious to the whole family.
  - Pray that whole families will give their life to Christ.
- Volunteers This year we are blessed to have more than 75 adult and youth volunteers! Wow! Our church has stepped up in such a tremendous way.
  - ♦ Pray for strength and endurance over a long week.
  - Pray for patience and love for all children under their supervision.
  - Pray for gospel conversations and wisdom on how to answer guestions.
