How do I know I am a Christian? How do I know I am really saved? How can I be sure I am going to heaven? I often get questions like these from individuals who are questioning how they can have assurance they are truly saved. They often are not questioning the reality of God or the truth of the Bible. They are questioning whether they have done the right things or taken the necessary steps to inherit eternal life. Few other questions have such important ramifications. Also, as they are wrestling with these questions there is a feeling of uncertainty and hopelessness.

How can we have full confident assurance that we are truly born again? Is that assurance even possible? This Sunday morning, we will begin a new sermon series through the book of 1 John. the entire theme of John's letter is about assurance of salvation. In 1 John 5:13, John says, "I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life." Throughout his letter John gives roughly 10 tests for us to examine ourselves so that we may know that we are truly Christ followers.

The purpose of this series is not to cause us to doubt or to despair over our salvation. Instead, it is to give us peace, knowing that we are in Christ. My prayer as we go through 1 John is that for some perhaps, they would experience true salvation for the very first time. On the other hand, for those that know Christ, I pray that this would be a time of examination leading to great joy as we rest in the finished work of Christ and not our own works.
