"When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest." (Matthew 9:36-37)

Jesus did not just look at the crowds, He saw them. He saw them! He saw them for who and what they truly were: sinners who were broken and marred by sin, sinners who could not save themselves, sinners who were lost without the Chief Shepherd.

This compelled Jesus to have compassion on them! I wonder if sometimes the church becomes more angry over seeing the world's sin rather than being broken over them. As long as we are repulsed by the world, we will not have compassion on them like Jesus did. There's a term for that - self-righteousness!

We were once harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd, until Jesus had compassion on us, saved us and redeemed us. When we realize that all people are just as helpless as we are, it compels us to have compassion on them.

Unfortunately, the enemy has deceived many believers into believing that God helps those who help themselves. Therefore, the laborers are few. But there is hope for us in this text! He tells us to pray! Prayer aligns our heart with God's heart, so when we pray for God to send laborers, we can't help but think, "maybe God wants to send me!"

Let me go ahead and tell you, He does want to send you! "As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you." (John 20:21) When you look at the world, see them in the same way Jesus sees them: harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Have compassion on them, and lead them to the Good Shepherd who can redeem them.
