## September 8, 2022 Newsletter

This Sunday we will be concluding our sermon series on the mission of First Baptist Surfside. We will be looking at the third and final statement in our mission: "We exist to glorify God as we...engage the nations with the gospel." Exalting Jesus leads to Equipping Christ Followers which leads to Engaging The Nations With The Gospel. We will see that each of us is called to, "Go therefore and make disciples" (Matthew 28:19). As we consider our call to make disciples, we recognize that we need to equip our church to do that. We can make disciples as we go throughout our day-to-day life, but we also want to help create outreach opportunities for our church. As we seek to follow the Acts 1:8 model here are ways that you can get involved with outreach in our church:

### Local missions to the Grand Strand (our Jerusalem)

- Equip 2 Engage – each Sunday nights our adults are learning how to share the gospel and will also spend several weeks doing intentional evangelism through prayer walking, phone calls, and more.
- Celebrate Recovery – each Tuesday night this ministry ministers to "recovering sinners." Each week individuals from all walks of life, those in our church to those who would never step through the door are pointed to Christ.
- Good News Club – this fall we will be restarting this incredible outreach that was paused during COVID. For six weeks we will be leading an afterschool program that shares the gospel in the public schools.

### Missions to South Carolina and the United States (Our Judea and Samaria)

- NYC - December 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> we will be sending a mission team to participate in a city-wide outreach called coats for the city. To sign up see Pastor Nathan or attend the interest meeting on September 25<sup>th</sup> after the second service.

### Missions to the World

- Haiti – each year we have several groups go to support a ministry in Haiti. This ministry is an orphanage, a hospital, and even a training facility for local pastors. If you are interested in being a part of any future trips, see Zane Wall or Vic Larsen.

These are just a few ways that our church is seeking to be on mission for the gospel. There are other ways through serving in our church ministries, your prayers, and your giving that you can be involved in fulfilling the Great Commission. We all have a part to play; what is yours?
