

# November 17, 2022 Newsletter

This week we will be concluding our ten-week journey though the book of 1 John. John writes to answer the most important question you will ever answer. A question many Christians struggle to answer. How do you know that you are saved? How do you know you are truly a Christian? In 1 John 5:13, John writes, "I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life" (ESV). John gives a series of ten questions, by which, believers can examine their faith to see if they are truly born again. Let me challenge you today, to take time to truly examine your faith today by these questions:

- 1. Do you believe the one true gospel? (1 John 1:1-4)
- 2. Has your new relationship with God led to a new relationship with sin? (1 John 1:5-2:6)
- 3. Has the gospel transformed your life? Are your outward actions changing? Are your desires, loves, and affections changing? (1 John 2:7-17)
- 4. Are you persevering in your faith? (1 John 2:18-27)
- 5. Are you looking more like your heavenly father? (1 John 2:28-3:10)
- 6. Are you loving more like your heavenly father? (1 John 3:11-23)
- 7. Is the Holy Spirit keeping you in truth? (1 John 3:24 -4:6)
- 8. Have you experienced true love? Are you loving others that way? (1 John 4:7-21)
- 9. Is there a noticeable difference between you and those who don't claim to be Christians? (1 John 5:1-12)
- 10. Does the Word of God in 1 John give you assurance? (1 John 5:13-21)

Today if you are in Christ, these areas may not be perfect, but you will see God working in your life. If that is you today, rejoice in your salvation and rest in the assurance that you are in Christ! If these questions do not give assurance, then what is keeping you from surrendering your life to Christ? Today, wherever you are stop what you are doing and cry out to God. Confess your sins to him ask him to save you. Surrender your life to him that you may know that you have eternal life!
