However, as the morning progressed, I was able to watch firsthand the epitome of Christlike service. Several of our men put on their raincoats, picked up umbrellas, and began walking people in from their cars. One-by-one they walked likely well over 100 people in from the rain, practically being soaked in the cold rain themselves. It was a reminder to me of the power of the body of Christ. It was the definition of Jesus' words in Matthew 23:11 that "The greatest among you shall be your servant." Did you get that? The greatest among us isn't the one who preaches or holds an office but is the one who walks people in from the rain! It is a reminder that as the body of Christ we all have a role to play. No matter what your role is there is no "insignificant" member of the body.

To those who served Sunday, and to all of those who serve in a hundred other ways that go unnoticed, thank you! You were the illustration of Jesus to our community. For the rest of us, let their example be a reminder of our call to serve others.
