This sounds good until we realize the idea of truth is fundamentally linked to other essential aspects of our life. Because there is no objective standard of truth in our society, we are also left with no objective standard of purpose, identity, meaning, or even morality. Is it any wonder that our society is more depressed, lonely, anxious, and hopeless than ever before?

This Sunday we will begin a new sermon series in 1 Timothy. Paul is writing to Timothy and tells him that one of the main functions of the church is to be "a *pillar of the truth*" (1 Tim 3:15). As our world is decaying around us, the church should stand firm on the truth. The idea of the truth should not cause us to boast as if we are superior but should humble us as God has entrusted to us the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Through 1 Timothy we see the beautiful picture that truth is not just a vague idea. Instead, truth is a person. Jesus came into this world to redeem us out of sin, and by putting our faith in "the truth" that is Jesus himself we might be forgiven and made new. Therefore, the most loving thing we can do as a church is tell others the truth of the gospel. It is only through the truth that we are made whole.

I hope you will join us this Sunday as we consider the truth and its many implications for the church.
