Have you ever wondered if the Bible addresses some of your deepest problems? Does the Bible tell me how to think about depression, anxiety, doubts or despair? Have you ever wondered if there was an easier way to know God's plan for your life? Do you ever feel like God's Word just isn't enough?

It is true that the Bible does not tell us literally everything we need to know. After all, the Bible is not a physics textbook, or a car manual, or an encyclopedia. However, God has revealed to us everything that we need in order to know God's will and live a life pleasing to Him.

Just as all Scripture is inspired by God and without error, all of Scripture is sufficient to make us "complete" and "equipped." God has given us, in the Bible, everything needed for "life and godliness."

This means at least four things for your life. First, the Bible must come before traditions, your experiences, and your feelings. "That's the way I've always done it" is not a good enough reason to do something if God has clearly said to do it differently. "I just feel like God would want me to do this" is also not a good enough reason to do something if God has clearly said otherwise. Remember that your heart can deceive you! But God's Word never will.

Second, sufficiency of the Bible means we do not need to add to it or take away from it. It is complete and it is perfect just as it is! We do not get to take out certain parts of Scripture simply because we may not agree with it. If we do not agree with something God has said, we are the ones that need to change, not God.

Third, sufficiency of Scripture means that God's Word is relevant to every area of your life. The Bible may not be a manual for plumbing, but it does tell me how to be a plumber that works for the glory of God. The Bible may not tell me who to marry, but it does tell me how to pursue relationships that honor God. The Bible speaks to us about fear and anxiety. The Bible speaks to us about how to make wise decisions. The Bible speaks to us about all areas of life.

Finally, the sufficiency of God's Word means that we have an open invitation to sit and listen to what God says. Whatever situation you find yourself in, whatever you are going through, God has something to say about it, and God's speech is enough. Are you willing to listen?


