So far this year, every week we have prayed for a people group that is "unreached." This means they do not have access to hear about Jesus because there may not be a Bible translated in their language and there are little to no Christians among them who are able to spread the good news of God's love in Jesus.

Prayer is often meant to align our heart and our desires with God's heart and desires. So, as you pray for God to raise up laborers to go into the harvest, your prayer might change from "Lord, send someone!" to "Lord, send me!" But how would I know if I am being called to missions?

In reality, asking if I am "called" to missions is asking the wrong question. You have been "commanded" to go and make disciples of all nations. You don't need a reason to go. You need a reason to stay.

With that being said, the church can't send out just anyone. The church must send out those who are biblically qualified and mature believers. Here are four basic questions for someone considering going to the nations:

- 1. Do you have an all-consuming desire for the work?
- 2. Are you already serving the church in some way?
- 3. Has the church affirmed your spiritual gifts and character qualifications?
- 4. If married, does your spouse also desire to go?

For some, it's time to start the conversation of what it looks like to go. For others, there is some maturing and growing that still needs to happen. For all of us, we must keep our eyes fixed on the vision of one day seeing "a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb." (Rev. 7:9)
