Have you read Daniel 11 yet? What a chapter! This week, I would appreciate your prayers as I prepare to preach Daniel 11. In more than 15 years of teaching the Bible, I do not know if I have ever attempted to preach a harder passage of scripture. So, in one sense, I want you to read Daniel 11 so you can share in my sufferings this week...just kidding! However, I would encourage you to read the passage of scripture every week before coming to church. That is one of the many advantages of expositional preaching; most Sundays you know where we will be next!

Here are a few benefits of you reading the passage before Sunday:

- 1) You will be ready to dive deep on Sunday. Instead of navigating through the passage for the first time you will be familiar with the bigger elements and ready to learn more.
- 2) You will be able to listen critically. When you know the passage, you are able to analyze what I am saying. You will be able to affirm what I am saying is true or refute any errors. Essentially you are my accountability! You encourage me to preach to the best of my ability.
- 3) You will be able to encourage others. The more familiar you are with the passage the better you will be able to have helpful conversations about the passage both before and after the service. How sweet would it be this week, for our church halls, for living rooms, for car rides, to be filled Sunday, December 10 with gospel centered conversations about Daniel!

I know it is longer and I know it is challenging. However, let me encourage you Tuesday, December 19 to read Daniel 11 this week and come ready to dive deep into God's Word on Sunday.
