However, though we have put the scary things away, each of us still live with fear in our hearts throughout the year. Many of us live fearful. Many of us are anxious. Many of us seem to always have an accelerated heartbeat and shortness of breath, as if we are always running from something.

Maybe that describes you, maybe you think that's an exaggeration. Regardless, you have fears. Have you ever had a hard time sharing the gospel with someone because you were afraid? Have you ever avoided a hard conversation that you knew needed to happen? Have you ever struggled with peer pressure? Do you find it hard to say no to people? Do you always second guess yourself because of what others may think? Do you lie, even little white lies to make yourself look better? Do you avoid people? Do other people often make you angry or depressed? Do you compare yourself with others? Do you find yourself anxious over what may happen tomorrow, or next week, or next year? Do you find yourself worrying about what could be? Do you often have thoughts that spiral downward to the worst case scenario? Do you worry about being exposed as a failure? Do you isolate yourself from others and not allow them to help you? Do you only share superficial prayer requests rather than admitting your sin struggles? If you have said yes to any of those questions—and I know you did!—then I want to personally invite you to join me this Sunday night, November 5 at 5:30 in the sanctuary.
