There are many different ways to measure the growth of a church. Typically, we focus on things like church attendance, membership, and budgets. While these are metrics of church growth, they are limited to tell us if a church is truly growing spiritually. That is why I believe an even more important metric of church growth is outreach. A church that is continuing to grow in their outward focus as well as their faithfulness to Tuesdays the Great Commission, is a church that is growing in health.

That is why I am proud of First Baptist Surfside. I believe over the past six months our church has grown more in outreach than we have in more than a decade. One example of that is in our participation in Coats For The City. For the second year our church has collected winter clothing items that will be distributed in a city-wide outreach in New York City during the first weekend of December. Our church collected more than Sunday, November 12 229 coats, 122 scarves, 189 toboggans, 133 pairs of gloves. Praise the Lord!

I am also excited that we are sending a mission team to participate in that outreach and distribute winter clothing items along with Grace Baptist Church in Brooklyn. Please be in prayer for the 22 from our church that will be going to New York, November 30th through December 3rd.

I am proud of my church! My prayer is that we would continue to grow in many areas, but especially in our faithfulness to tell others about Jesus!
