As we fully enter the Christmas season, I wonder, how are things for you? If Weekly Schedule you could summarize your life in just one word, what would it be? Great? Joy? Anxious? Fear? Today I wonder if anyone would honestly say, "peace?"

I look around our world and all I see is chaos. Wars, division, injustice, hate, broken families, hurting children, and angry people. Every day I see people desperately seeking peace. That is why, starting Sunday, we will spend the next few weeks focusing on the promise in Luke 2 of "peace on earth." We will see how to find peace with God, peace with others, and even peace within.

What we will find is that the promise of peace in Luke 2 will not be given to every person on earth. Instead, Luke 2:14 says, "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased!" Did you catch that? The peace of God will only be experienced with those whom he is pleased.

The most important question this Christmas is this: is God is pleased with you? The follow up question is what then can we do for God to be pleased with us? The simple answer is to look in a manger. God is not pleased with us because of our good works, or our religious duties. He is pleased with us because Isaiah 53 says God crushed his son on a cross. The baby in the manger would grow into a man to die on behalf of the sins of the world. Today, if we would repent Wednesday, December 20 and trust in Jesus, we would gain new and everlasting life.

So where do we find peace? We find it in a lowly manger. We find peace with ourselves and with others only when we find true peace with God.
