

Coexist or Contradict?

Driving down Highway 17, I often see interesting bumper stickers. One that always catches my eye is the sticker that simply says, "Coexist." Each letter is a symbol that represents another religion. For example, the "C" is the Islamic crescent moon, a representation of Islam, "X" is the star of David from Judaism, and the "T" is a cross representing Christianity. For some, the sticker is simply a call to peace among differing ideologies and religions.

At the same time, for many, "Coexist" is not just a call to peace, it represents the greater philosophy of our age. We live in a postmodern world that does not simply call for peace with other ideas, but that we are to fully accept other beliefs as valid. This translates into a pluralistic view of God. That is, there is not just one way to God, but many ways to God. Jesus is one way to come to God, but Islam is another and equally valid Saturday, February 17 path to God. That sounds nice, but is that what the Bible teaches?

This Sunday night in our adult teaching time (Equip 2 Engage) we are going to ask the question, "Coexist or Contradict?" We are going to Sunday, February 18 discuss that yes, we should seek peace with everyone, but we cannot biblically call all other paths to God valid. We will discuss the exclusivity of the gospel and how to respond to others who believe in multiple paths.
