"Hindsight is 20/20!" But is it, really?

In Deuteronomy, Moses renews God's covenant with Israel, since they are about to go into the land of Canaan and Moses will not be going with them. In chapter 8. Moses offers a series of reminders to the people.

Moses reminds them how God has led them by His hand for the last 40 years, encouraging them to remember God's providence (Deut 8:2). Moses reminds them how they were hungry and in need after they left Egypt and how God miraculously fed them with manna, encouraging them to remember their dependence on God (Deut 8:3). Moses reminds them how their clothes and shoes never wore out during the four decades of wandering in the wilderness, encouraging them to remember God's intimate care for them (Deut 8:4).

Israel had endured a season of hardship in the wilderness, but they were about to enjoy a season of blessing in the promised land. How could they forget all that God had done for them? Yet, Moses knew it was possible. He tells them, "Take care lest you forget the LORD your God...Beware, lest you say in your heart, 'My power and the might of my hand have gotten me this wealth.' You shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth." (Deut 8:11-18)

Hindsight might be blurry sometimes. We don't always see things clearly. The Saturday, March 30 people of Israel knew of God's sovereign hand, yet they often looked back and saw themselves as the hero of their story.

Thus says the LORD: "Let not the wise man boast in his wisdom, let not the mighty man boast in his might, let not the rich man boast in his riches, but let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am the LORD who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth. For in these things I delight, declares the LORD."
