Here is our plan for Easter weekend:

Saturday, March 30th – Easter Egg-stravaganza – We will be having a celebration for the whole family. We are going to be switching things up this year. We will start at 9:00am with a pancake breakfast. Then we will transition into the sanctuary to hear the gospel, followed by the Easter Egg Hunt outside.

Sunday, March 31st – Easter Sunday – We have several ways to worship on Easter Sunday:

- **Sunrise Service** – 6:45am at the Surfside Pier. Parking will be available at River City Café and Town Parking through 8:00am.
- **On Campus** – we will have both our 9:00am and 10:30am Services. During that time will have a drop in breakfast from 8:15 – 10:00am. Therefore, we will not have youth or adult small groups that morning. Childcare from 5th grade and under will be available during both services.
- **Kids Celebration** – during the 10:30am service. Instead of dismissing kids during the service, kids can be dropped off in the education building before service.
