

Almost every week we see the headline, "Church closes its doors." There is a picture of a once vibrant church now a shadow of its former self. A church that once was active and influential in the community now a memory. While each is different, it is a reminder of the greater narrative of the decline of the American church. So, what needs to happen for our church not to be just another statistic, but we would continue to be a church that actively influences our culture for Jesus?

Richard Niebuhr in his book, "Christ and culture," gives three different options we have to interact with our culture:

- 1. Christ Against Culture in which we would have an "us vs them" mentality. Where we make our culture the enemy or retract from the culture, isolating ourselves in our Christian bubble. The issue is that while we as Christians should be distinct from our culture, we are called to impact our culture for the gospel.
- 2. **Christ of Culture** instead of being against, we should embrace culture. This takes the form of a church trying to be more "relevant" and look like the culture. The issue is that when churches try to look like the culture we do not look "relevant" we look ridiculous and lose our credibility.
- 3. Christ Above Culture we as Christians are not superior to anyone. However, we recognize that Jesus is greater than our culture. Therefore, Jesus is not changed by our culture, but our culture is changed by Jesus. As Christians we are not called to retreat from our culture in fear or to be like our culture. Instead, we are to go into our culture and see it transformed by the gospel.

This Sunday, I hope you will join us as we continue our time in Romans. In Romans 12:14-21 Paul shows us how we are to impact our culture for Christ. He shows us that the love of Christ that transforms us, should motive us to transform our culture.
